Well care visits play an important role in your child's health. Well care visits include measurements, screenings, development and behavioral assessments, a thorough physical exam, and anticipatory guidance to help keep your child healthy. The schedule below lists the normal measurements and assessments that take place at well care visits.

Meningococcal (Menactra) * Initial vaccine at 11-12 years with booster after 4-5 years 2. Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Tdap/Adacel) at 11 - 12 years 3. Other immunizations as needed (Hep A, HPV-Gardasil)

An annual flu shot is recommended for all children 6 months and older. After the age of two, routine physical exams are recommended every year. If your child chooses to participate in high school athletics an annual physical is required.
